## WHITE WINES

### South Africa...

<b>1. CHENIN BLANC, KIRABO, WORCESTER</b>	3.10	4.30	12.50
A young Chenin with bright glittering colour, displays aromas of dry apricots. Vivacious with a good fruit finish.			

### Argentina...

<b>2. CHARDONNAY, MAIPU, TRAPICHE</b>	3.70	5.20	15.00
Silver green colour, this delightful Chardonnay charms you with the citrus and mango bouquet, medium body with a lot of vivacity and splendid long finish.			

### Australia...

<b>3. CHARDONNAY, ARLINGTON ESTATE, MOORABOOL</b>			14.00
Medium bodied, a light silvery colour with a nose of melon, ripe peach spectrum enhanced by a light passage in French oak.			

### Chile...

<b>4. SAUVIGNON, RESERVA, TARAPACA</b>	3.40	4.40	14.50
A light silver colour verging into green releasing a bouquet of gooseberries mingled with dry apricot. The oak is well integrated and has a full body, it is dry with a clean taste.			

### France...

<b>5. GRENACHE BLANC, PONT MICHEL, VIN DE PAYS D'OC</b>	3.10	4.30	12.50
Lemony colour, floral, rose petals, light in body with drinking. Dry with a crispiness on the finish.			

<b>6. PETIT CHABLIS, DOMAINE DE LA TOUR</b>	4.90	6.50	18.50
Light silvery colour, zesty and zingy with a floral nose and a true taste of chablis. Beautifully balanced wine, long and generous.			

<b>7. POUILLY FUISSE, SAINT ROCHE</b>			21.00
Light yellow colour, it has a bouquet of green limes and pineapple, full bodied, dry with a delicious creamy guava fresh finish.			

<b>8. SANCERRE, DOMAINE PATRICE MOREUX, LOIRE</b>			21.00
Light gold with silver tints, floral bouquet of acacias, dry with aromas of gunflint and lemon fruit.			

<b>9. CHABLIS 1ER CRU, BEAUROY, COLOMBIER</b>			22.00
Light gold, fragrant bouquet of brioche, hint of pears with a crispy finish.			

<b>10. CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE BLANC, DOMAINE ROGER PERRIN</b>			29.00
Brilliant light gold displaying fruit, green apples, yellow peaches and pineapple flavours, attractive to the palate.

### Germany...

<b>11. RIESLING, KABINETT, BLUE BOTTLE, MOSEL (MEDIUM)</b>	3.50	4.90	14.00
Pale silvery colour from the Mosel Valley, lovely perfumed nose of lime and apple, mineral character, mouthfillingly fresh.			

### Italy...

<b>12. PINOT BIANCO, SALVALAI</b>	3.40	4.80	13.00
Pale silvery colour with golden highlights, aromatic with fresh apple bouquet. Refreshingly peachy palate with a gentle finish.			
<b>13. PINOT GRIGIO, RENANA ALTA, SACHETTO</b>	3.90	5.50	15.00
A stunning wine, clear and bright with a direct impact of exotic fruit on the nose. Soft and full of crisp apple fruit on the palate.			
<b>14. PINOT GRIGIO CRU, BOSCO DEL MERLO, ORGANIC</b>			19.00
A famous cru from Lison Prammaggiore. Light pale colour with smokey reflections, an intense and well defined bouquet of nutmeg and acacia blossom, a dry, full fruit taste of aromatic lychees.			

### New Zealand...

<b>15. PINOT GRIS, QUARRY ROAD, TE KAUWHATA</b>			17.00
A rare variety in New Zealand growing near the shores of Lake Waikare. Light glittering colour, vanilla bouquet, fragrant apples and pears, medium dry with incredible freshness on the palate.			
<b>16. SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, QUARRY ROAD</b>			18.00
Magic in a bottle! Gold green colour, pure gooseberries leading onto a passion fruit palate. Clean and crisp.			

## RED WINES

### Argentina...

<b>17. BONARDA TEMPRANILLO, PIEDRA LUNA</b>	3.10	4.30	12.50
The invitingly ripe smell of sun kissed strawberries and raspberries draws you to this juicy, fruity wine, lightly oaked, with just enough tannins to give it some backbone and bite.			
<b>18. MALBEC, ANDEAN VINEYARDS, MENDOZA</b>	4.00	5.60	15.50
Rich red colour with splendid aromas of violets. Taste of red berries and chocolatey fruit.			
<b>19. SHIRAZ, OAK AGED, MAIPU, TRAPICHE, ARGENTINA</b>			16.50
Deep almost black Syrah, displays a bouquet of dried fruit, blackberry, chocolate and cigar, full bodied, rich with a vanilla, blackberry palate, interesting wine.			

### Australia...

<b>20. SHIRAZ, CABERNET, MERLOT, HAWKES HILL</b>	3.40	4.80	13.50
Dark red colour, aromas of cassis and brambles, medium body, soft to the palate, with plenty of residual fruit.			
<b>21. PEPPER BLACK SHIRAZ LEAF SERIES, VICTORIA</b>			18.00
Deep black colour, Huge bouquet with little fruits. Ripe plums, blackberries on a vanilla pepper underlay. The palate is full flavoured, chocolate, black figs with a dazzling finish of liquorice and spice.

<b>22. MERLOT, LOS SARMIENTOS</b>	3.40	4.80	12.95
<p>This Merlot has aromas of blackberries, violets and raspberries. The ripe plum and currant flavours are overlaid with touches of coffee and chocolate. Well balanced with round tannins and a long, rich finish.</p>			
<b>23. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, ADOBE, COLCHAGUA VALLEY</b>			16.50
<p>Deep red cherry colour, seductive berry fruit, full body, soft on the palate leaving a graceful, chocolate, cinnamon flavour.</p>			

### France...

<b>24. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, PONT MICHEL</b>	3.10	4.30	12.50
<p>Cherry colour a pleasant nose of little ripe fruit, superb drinking and a medium body. A natural taste of Cabernet Sauvignon.</p>			
<b>25. MERLOT, LES PERLES LA MEDITERANEE</b>			15.50
<p>A delightful apogee of Southern French wine. Gleaming purple red colour, scents of mature raspberries falling on a floral fresh pine mineral palette.</p>			
<b>26. CHATEAU GRAND MOULIN, MONTAGNE, ST EMILION</b>			19.00
<p>Easy to enjoy, spicy nose with a good clean fruit and berries. On the palate there is a reappearance of cassis.</p>			
<b>27. FLEURIE, CHÂTEAU DES LABOURONS, BURGUNDY</b>	half -	10.00	19.00
<p>A medal winner in Paris. An exciting wine, brilliant ruby red colour, with a bouquet of violet and raspberry, good body with a lush, silky finish.</p>			
<b>28. VOLNAY, SELECTION JEAN LUC POUTEAU</b>			20.00
<p>Brilliant red colour, bouquet of cloves, remaining peppery in the mouth and good body.</p>			
<b>29. CHÂTEAU DE MALLERET, CRU, MEDOC</b>			24.50
<p>Superb dark colour, aromas of cassis and vanilla, good body on the palate showing a lot of soft fruit and length.</p>			
<b>30. CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE, ROUGE, DOMAINE ROGER PERRIN</b>			29.00
<p>Medal Winner. A fine deep red with a wonderful bouquet of truffles, pepper and nutmeg. Expansively rich, robust on a spicy black cherry finish.</p>			

### Italy...

<b>31. MERLOT, SALVALAI</b>	3.40	4.80	13.50
<p>A dark ruby wine, medium bodied with an instant fragrance of wild red berries, velvety and leaving a clean round taste with plenty of fruit still on the finish.</p>			
<b>32. VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO SUPERIORE LE BESSOLE, ACCORDINI</b>			15.50
<p>Black prune colour, intense fruity fragrance, rich and creamy red with good substance, leaving the palate very satisfied with a lingering taste of blackcurrant fruit.</p>			
<b>33. AMARONE, CLASSICO, LE BESSOLE, ACCORDINI</b>			26.00
<p>Deep pomegranate colour, rich, intense with opulent plum and black cherry aromas, dried fruit, figs, banana and dates, very approachable leaving a superb condensed berry taste.</p>

#### 34. MERLOT MALBEC, QUARRY ROAD, TE KAWHATA

17.50

A marriage of juicy damsons and layered melted chocolate. Dark fruits carry onto an oaky richness and spice on the palate.

#### 35. PINOT NOIR, VINEYARD SELECTION, MUDHOUSE

19.00

From Central Otago, the finest region for Pinot Noir, aromas of condensed strawberries, with layers of succulent redcurrants and cloves.

### Spain...

#### 36. RIOJA TINTO, MONTE OCIJO, BIURKO GORRI

3.70 5.20 14.50

A well made wine. Deep purple colour, bouquet of freshly picked little berry fruit, slight hint of vanilla and coconut.

#### 37. RIOJA RESERVA, BIURKO GORRI

17.50

This newly received reserva has spent 36 months in the Bodega after bottling. Cherry colour, fine bouquet of cigar box, blackcurrant - prunes, plenty of Garnacha flavour with a good structure.

## ROSE OF THE WORLD

#### 38. PINOT GRIGIO, ROSATO BLUSH, ITALY

3.50 4.90 14.00

Very light pinky salmon colour, bouquet of rose petals and raspberry. A fresh and delightful finish.

#### 39. ROSADO DE LAGRIMA, RIOJA, TOBIA, SPAIN

3.70 5.20 15.00

A brilliant dark rosé, juicy red fruit aromas, very fruity reminiscent of strawberries and apple. Zingy and vivacious in the mouth.

## SPARKLING / SEMI-SPARKLING

#### 40. BACICHETTO ROSATO, SEMI SPARKLING, ITALY

15.50

Semi sparkling, glistening pink, bouquet of freshly picked pomegranate and a strawberry silkiness flowing on the palate.

#### 41. CREMANT DE LIMOUX, CUVÉE PRESTIGE, DOMAINE COLLIN

18.50

The oldest Brut in the World. Created before Dom Perignon. Phillippe Collin, proprietor is an ex Champagne man who uses his skills in his organically produced Limoux. Light gold with aromas of acacia and baked biscuits.

## CHAMPAGNE

#### 42. LEBLANC COLOMBIER CUVÉE, CELESTE BRUT

30.00

Light silver colour, predominantly Chardonnay with a slight biscuity bouquet, and a clean, off dry palate of vanilla and lemon zest with appealing length. This hand-crafted Champagne is both creamy in both taste and texture.

#### 43. VEUVE CLICQUOT PONSARDIN, YELLOW LABEL

40.00

One of the trendiest of Champagne houses. A brilliant colour with yellow tints. Fine mousse with a lychee fruit and floral nose.
